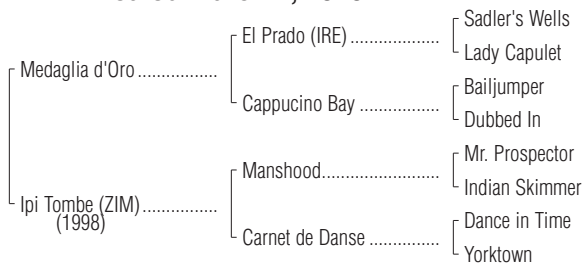

[G1] (PIM, \$660,000), etc.), and of Passion for Gold [G1] (hwt. in France, \$268,125), Champagne d'Oro (\$572,465, Bet-fair TVG Acorn S. [G1] (BEL, \$180,000), etc.), Gabby's Golden Gal [G1].

Hand., 7 - 9 1/2 fur., Dubai Duty Free [G1], Jebel Hatta [G3], Al Fahidi Fort; winner in 1 start at 5, \$101,928, in N.A./ U.S., Locust Grove H. [G3] (CD, \$101,928). (Total: \$1,416,273). Spanish Duet. 3 wins at 3 in South Africa.
